Embodying sleek and sophisticated elegance, Downtown Gallery scenography's always stand out thanks to a selection of iconic design pieces and also lightings that show off the gallery's space. For this London edition, the gallery will specifically honor the works of the French artist Richard Texier among which one can admire the floor lamp «*Savana Circus* » or the candlestick «*Aquatic Candelabra* ». Famous for his pieces that glorify fauna and flora, Richard Texier's sculptural objects obey the laws of hybridization. For this zoology enthusiast, his art is the testimony of his addiction to the forces of nature as well as the way to celebrate the beauty of the world.

Alongside the creations of Richard Texier, the gallery will also present other iconic pieces of museum quality, celebrating great names in architecture and design such as Pierre Jeanneret, Jean Pouvré, or Charlotte Perriand whose famous «Mexico» Library produced in 1953 will be on show at the London fair.

Since its opening in the early 80's, the Laffanour / Galerie Downtown Paris, created by François Laffanour, has been exploring and exhibiting the furniture of 20th century architects, contributing to the rehabilitation and valorization of the masters of post-war architecture.

In the aftermath of the Second World War, designers and architects brought a new conception to the art of furnishing, dictated by a need for freedom and efficiency, in the service of a new art of living in an era of technological and scientific development, but also sociological, demographic and social.

The Laffanour / Galerie Downtown Paris also holds the archives of the Steph Simon Gallery which, from 1956 to 1974, represented and published the furniture of Charlotte Perriand, Jean Prouvé, Serge Mouille, Georges Jouve and Isamu Noguchi.
